The 23.7 MGD plant processes feedwater from the nearby Moselle River, providing drinking water for over 150,000 people in the surrounding area. The Moselle River has the pollution issues typical of similar urban regions – the HYDRAcap® modules serve as the "last chance" barrier for cryptospyridium, giardia and other viruses, and also decrease turbidity. These modules have earned an ACS, or *Attestation de Conformité Sanitaire*, certification. Awarded by the *Laboratoire Hygiene et de Recherche en Santé Publique* in France, the certification is recognized throughout Europe. France requires this demanding certification for all equipment and technology used in handling water for human consumption. At Nancy, the UF HYDRAcap® modules replace the previous ultraviolet treatment system.

Hydranautics' HYDRAcap® product line meets the pathogen rejection and economic operation required by most municipalities. The capillary UF HYDRAcap® modules represent state-of-the-art technology and provide superior performance as compared to microfiltration. The technology has exhibited up to 5-log virus removal, thus exceeding USEPA regulations for potable water use as per the Surface Water Treatment Rule.
